



CPL Rogelio V. Vasquez, VET. USMC

Rogelio Vasquez died peacefully in the Audie Murphy Veterans Hospital in San Antonio, TX on March 11, 2023 with his wife, sister Margarita, and brother-in-law Cruz by his bedside.
