Elizabeth Sue Murdoch peacefully entered into the arms of her Lord on Wednesday, September 1, 2021, in Del Rio, Tx. She was born in Dallas, Texas on February 14, 1933, to her predeceased parents, Eugene Homer Hopkins and Susie Inez Vaughan Hopkins. Her brother, Homer Eugene Hopkins and her sister, Ina Gene Hopkins Evans also preceded her in death.

She married James (Jim) Murrell Murdoch on September 12, 1951, in Dallas, Tx. From their marriage they had two children Vicki Sue Murdoch Judice and James (Jimmy) Lawrence Murdoch.
