He shared a story while living in Mexico as a child and going to bed numerous nights on an empty stomach, and walking through the streets smelling the food from restaurants. He made a commitment to always help others not feel the pain of hunger.

He loved life and lived it to the fullest. He never doubted that God would place him at the right place and meet a woman that would love him forever and unconditionally. So during a hot and humid September 16 Celebration, he met Rachel, and it was love at first sight. From that moment on, two hearts became one heart overflowing with love for each other. And so began their "Happily Ever After" chapter. Their 39 years of marriage was filled with bliss and harmony together with understanding and acceptance.

One of the proudest moments was when he became a U.S. Citizen in 1974.

He worked for the Texas Department of Transportation where he retired after 24 years of service. He loved the outdoors, planting trees and shrubs, and mowing the lawn.
