



Larry Edward Martwig (MAJ USAF, VET)

April 20, 1945 - January 7, 2025

Larry Edward Martwig (MAJ USAF, VET) passed away on Tuesday, January 7, 2025, at age 79, while beside his loving wife here in Del Rio.

Larry was born in Paris, Arkansas, and raised in Cedar Rapids, Iowa where he graduated from George Washington High School and Coe College. While he was in high school, he found his love for flying as a member of the Civil Air Patrol.

Larry served 14 years as a pilot in the United States Air Force and was a Vietnam war veteran assigned to the 459th Tactical Airlift Squadron. His last duty station in the Air Force was here in Del Rio as an instructor pilot. Larry took great pride in teaching the next generation of pilots. After many years as a civilian, he returned to his teaching role as a simulator instructor at Laughlin AFB.

Larry loved this community. He was a member of the First United Methodist Church and of the Del Rio Lions Club (serving as past president from 2015-16). He was also proud to serve as past president of the Del Rio chapter of the Texas Air Force Association.

Preceding him in death were his parents, Ruth and Arthur Martwig; and brother, Jerry Martwig. His surviving family includes his wife of 57 years,

Marva A. Martwig of Del Rio; son Jason Martwig of Austin, TX; daughter, Sara Tweedie and son-in-law Steve Tweedie of Plano, TX. Larry is "Papa" to two grandchildren, Sean and Mariel Tweedie. Larry is also survived by his nephew, Brent Martwig of Cedar Rapids, Iowa.

A memorial service will be held February 1st at 2:00 p.m. at the First United Methodist Church.
