March 23, 1943 - May 8, 2023

SHARON ELAINE CASH, age 80, passed away peacefully on Monday May 8, 2023, in San Angelo, Texas.

Sharon, or as some family loving called her, "Butchie", was born March 23, 1943 in Del Rio, Tx to Roy D. & Billye Cash of Langtry, Tx and raised on the family ranch just north of Langtry.

When I got to her ranch house, Sharon was sad because she believed Johnny Reb wasn't going to make it. When he saw me, old Johnny Reb jumped down off the couch and let me pet him. She started to cry. He took food and water from me and she was very happy. We talked for most of my shift, and I even helped her change her oven heating element. Ultimately, Johnny Reb succumbed to his injury. My family and I visited her in the hospital when she broke her leg. I'll always remember how upset she was at me because I showed up unannounced and she didn't have time to put on her makeup. We lost touch after the ranch sold and she moved to Ozona, since it wasn't in my patrol area, but I loved her as if she was my own aunt.
